


Adobe Creative Cloud - Online install instructions

1. Login to your School Learnlink email account.



If you do not know your Learnlink login details you will need to have your password reset at school.


2. Open the email from Adobe Creative Cloud.




3. Click on the "Get Started" button.




4. Enter your name details and a password to continue.



5. Correctly enter your date of birth & click "Update"



6. You are now signed in to Adobe Online. Click on "Desktop Apps" to view available downloads.




A page showing available software will now be displayed. Please note that all Adobe Creative Cloud downloads can be quite large. If you do not have a broadband connection with plenty of data allocation, you may wish to use the offline installers available on the school network.


If you have plenty of data and wish to continue I recommend starting with the "Creative Cloud" desktop management app. This will then allow you to easily manage the rest of your Adobe software installs. Alternatively you may just install one individual app.

7. Click on "Download" to download "Creative Cloud".




8. Fill in the requested details and "Continue".




9. Follow the on screen instructions to download and run the installer.

Now downloading. Here's what to do next:




1. Open the Creative Cloud installer


2. Install the Creative Cloud desktop app




The installation will start. This may take some time depending on your internet connection.



10. Once installed, Sign in with your Learnlink email address and the password that you created in step 4.



11. Once signed in, Click on the "Apps" tab to see the list of available apps to install.



12. Available Apps for your computer can now be installed when required, by clicking install.
